

CITY OF NEW HOLSTEIN RESIDENTS GARBAGE & RECYCLING INFORMATION FOR THE REMAINDER OF 2021

PLEASE READ IMPORTANT INFORMATION

As of September 30, 2021, the City will begin waste and recycling pick up services with **GFL**. Continue to use your current garbage and recycle cans until new cans are delivered to your residence.

The expected delivery of new garbage and recycle cans is early November 2021 and every resident will receive a 90-gallon waste container and a 90-gallon garbage container. (If you have multiple cans at your property, GFL will be made aware of it and will deliver the appropriate quantity.)



Once you receive your new cans from GFL, you will need to drop your old cans at the south parking lot of Tecumseh, 1614 Michigan Ave (see map). The cans will be picked up by GFL. If you need assistance getting your can to this location, contact City Hall.

On Thursday, September 30, the entire city will receive GARBAGE pick-up.

On Thursday, October 7, the entire city will receive both GARBAGE and RECYCLING pick-up.

After that date follow the schedule below.

Garbage Pickup

Garbage pickup in New Holstein is every Thursday beginning at 5:00AM, or on Friday's if a holiday falls during that week. For new service or a broken container call New Holstein City Hall at 920-898-5766.

Recycle Curbside Collection Dates

Recyclables are picked up on Thursday's (see schedule below) beginning at 5:00AM or on Friday's if a holiday falls during that week, marked with * below. **Please see directions on reverse side regarding preparation, sorting and what's recyclable. Any further questions contact GFL at (920)687-2631 (choose option 3).**

City of New Holstein Waste and Recycling Cart Guide

- Place all recyclable material into your cart. There is no need to separate paper from glass, aluminum, plastic or tin.
- DO NOT place ANY plastic bags in your recycling cart
- Do not place trash in your recycling cart
- All recyclables must fit inside your cart with the lid closed. Place your recycling cart with the front of the lid facing the street and the wheels of the cart towards your house.
- Place your recycling cart 4ft away from obstructions such as mailboxes, utility poles, trees and cars.
- Keep your recycling cart 4 ft away from your garbage can. The best solution is to put your garbage can and recycling cart on opposite sides of the driveway.
- Cart cannot be placed on top of snowbanks, they must be ground level.
- Make sure you place your cart at the curb by 5am the day of pick up or the night before. Please remove your cart 24 hours after collection.
- Reminder- Yard waste is NOT allowed in either garbage cans or recycling carts.

Curbside Recycling Guide

Place recyclables loosely in your bin. **No plastic bags!**

Plastic

ACCEPT:

ALL plastic bottles & containers

- Household bottles, jars & jugs
- Dairy containers & lids
- Produce, bakery & deli containers & lids

DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Plastic bags, wrap or film
- Motor oil bottles
- Styrofoam



empty, rinse & replace caps/lids

Paper

ACCEPT:

- Newspapers & inserts
- Cardboard & paperboard (food boxes)
- Milk, juice & soup cartons
- Office & school paper
- Junk mail & catalogs
- Phonebooks, books & magazines

DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Tissue paper
- Pet food bags

Metal

ACCEPT:

- Aluminum bottles & cans
- Steel & tin cans
- Empty aerosol cans

DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Aluminum pans or foil
- Empty paint cans
- Scrap metal

Glass

ACCEPT:

- Food and beverage bottles & jars

DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Window glass
- Ceramics, china
- Drinking glasses
